Tracking means determining the current location, and

tracing means determining past locations of an item being delivered, generally using barcodes or RFID technology.

Thus, <u>tracing means following</u> the footsteps or <u>a continuous line</u> of something with the goal of finding the route (the journey), whereas <u>tracking means finding a spot</u> here and there where intermittent tracks have been left with the goal of finding the item or animal (the destination).

a **HAZARD** is anything that may cause harm, such as chemicals, electricity, working from ladders

the **RISK** is the frequency, high or low, that somebody could be harmed by these and other hazards, together with an indication of how serious the harm could be

a **NEAR MISS** [mancato incidente /infortunio] is an unplanned event that has the potential to cause, but does not actually result in human injury, environmental or equipment damage, or an interruption to normal operation

record keeping [TENUTA DEI REGISTRI]

to conduct a self-assessment AGAINST the Standard
